### **Testing**

- Everyone must carry out an LFT test (and confirm a negative result) before attending.
- If you feel unwell, please do not attend.

# Cleaning and hygiene

- Use hand sanitiser where provided, please use it before entering the hall.
- Wash and sanitise hands after using the toilet
- Bring and use your own Bibles and hymn books
